# In 2011-2012, the AIIC-Canada Region took stock of the Association and the

profession, concerned about dwindling support. In 2017, after a 4-year campaign with the Canadian Federal Government's Translation Bureau for a more equitable procurement contracting system, the Region now enjoys increased support and rising membership numbers. The Region's recent Autumn One-Day event this past October, which attracted 70 interpreters and notable guest speakers, is evidence of AIIC-Canada's rising fortunes.
